### **Annual Herd Inventories**

A reminder that the 2026 Herd Inventories have been sent to all Members. The forms are to be completed and returned to the ABRI office prior to invoicing. Those that have not returned their completed Animal Inventories by 31<sup>st</sup> of March, will be invoiced in full in April. Annual completion of your herd inventory is an important requirement for members of the Australian Belted Galloway Association. It allows the association to ensure that the herd book is maintained accurately, ensures that you are invoiced correctly, and determines the number of Council members for the following year (we like more Council members – it allows more people to share the load and this improves services to members). Please contact Trudi or a Councillor if you require assistance to complete the forms.

### **Hypotrichosis Testing Incentive**

Last year the ABGA Council offered a financial incentive for those wanting to test their bulls for Hypotrichosis. We have decided to extend this offer and allow it to include **ALL** test results from members who submit their Hypotrichosis Test results with their 2026 Animal Inventory and registrations. The ABGA will waive the levy and registration fees for any eligible animals.

For animals to be eligible to receive this incentive,

The test results from NSW DPI or Zoetis must clearly state the animal's name (preferably the tattoo or registration number also) and be submitted between the 1<sup>st</sup> of January and the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2026. The incentive will still be honoured for registrations that are submitted during this period, pending the delay of genetic test results. Please note that by submitting these results, you agree to have this information included on online database and the results publicly available, which will be done once this has been set up. Members can be assured that currently any animals found to be confirmed Hypo carriers will not have their registration affected. If there are any future changes to this as council establish management processes, consultation with members and sufficient notice will be given and this will not affect the standing registrations of any carrier animals registered before any changes were made. A reminder to members that animals who test positive as hypo affected should not be submitted for registration.

### **2027 Bi – Annual Magazine**

We are already planning the 2027 Bi – Annual Magazine. This Magazine will be available to all Members and will be a great way to promote your stud and market our wonderful Belted Galloway breed on a local and international level.

We will be looking for articles, photos, experiences and achievements. It does not matter how long you have been breeding Belties for, or how many Belties you have. We want to hear from as many breeders as possible. Advertising opportunities will be available.
